Priorities:

1. Detailed website to list all healthcare and wellness services available in the county. Either link with Chamber of Commerce or the pending Economic Dev. Website. (Goal #1)
2. Survey Nursing and Pre-Med students from both universities concerning the possibilities of returning to Clark County. (Goal #5)
3. Research the possibility of mail out packets to medical/dental and nursing students giving information about Clark County. This could be a project that is done in the Tri-state area including Job Fairs. (Goal #5)
4. Research Funding opportunities for merit pay or bonuses for nurses who stay in Clark County such as what is offered in Education (Goal #5)
5. Meet with HSU Nursing Dept in regards to reinstating the Kindergarten Round Up Program to offer free immunizations and check ups to children of Clark County. (Goal #4)
